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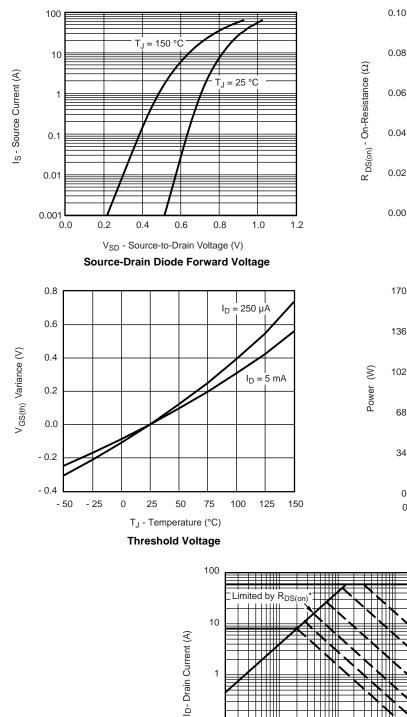

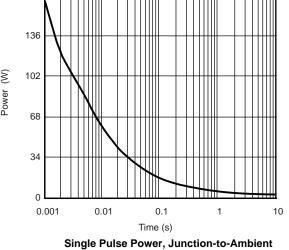

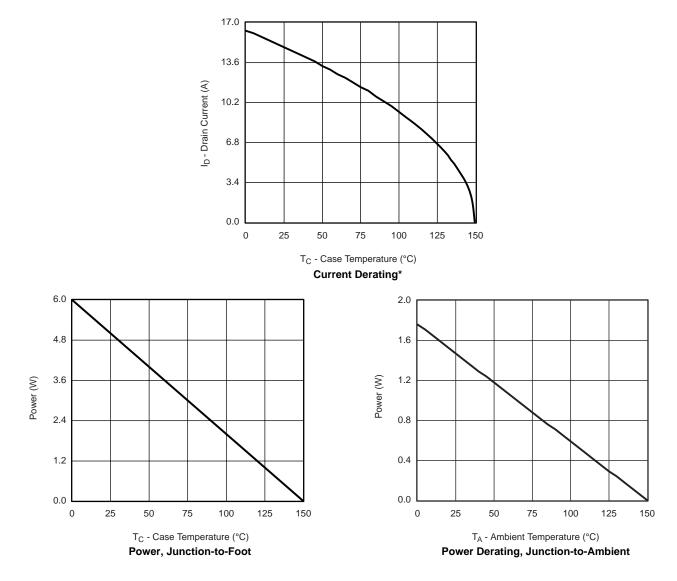
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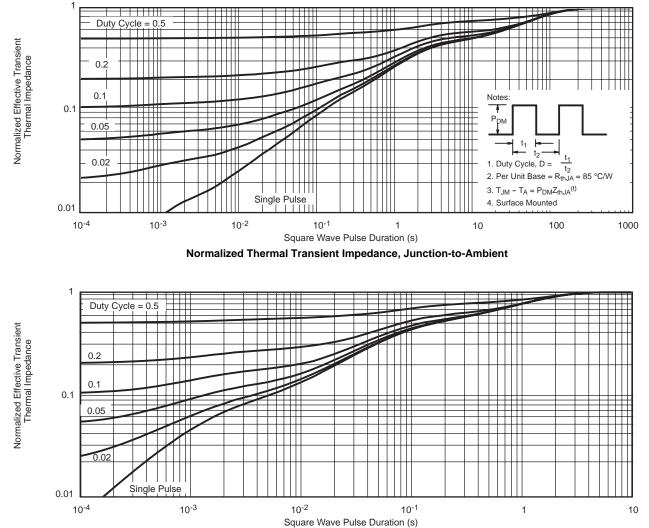


MOSFET TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS 25 °C, unless otherwise noted

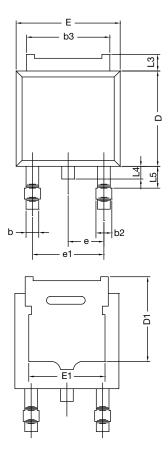
TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS 25 °C, unless otherwise noted

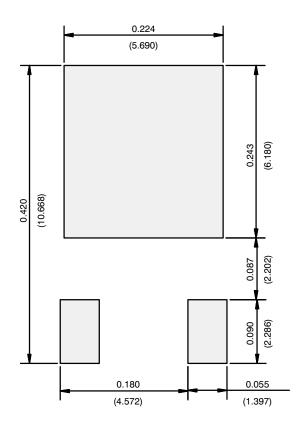
