


Transconductance






**On-Resistance vs. Drain Current** 




**Gate Charge** 






**On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature** 




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Source Drain Diode Forward Voltage











Safe Operating Area




